

Last Chance Audubon Society (LCAS) Scholarship Application, Selection Process and Schedule 2016 - 2017 Academic Year

LCAS application, selection process and schedule is posted on LCAS website in November and High School contacts (Lisa Richards at Capital High and Nancy Oliveira at Helena High) are notified by email that it has been posted. (lrichards@helenaschools.org and noliveira@helenaschools.org)

1. Students download application form, complete application, and email to scholarship@lastchanceaudubon.org with a teacher's letter of recommendation. (Teacher's letters can be emailed separately, if preferred.)
2. Applications are due no later than April 15, 2017 to allow enough time for college admission notifications/decisions.
3. LCAS's three-member selection committee will review applications, rank applicants individually, and reach committee consensus on awards by the end of April. Up to two awards will be made each year.
4. LCAS selection committee will make recommendations to LCAS Board by email prior to the May Board meeting. The Board will render a final award decision prior to the May membership meeting.
5. All students, regardless of scholarship award success will be notified of the Board decision. Students selected are invited to the May LCAS membership meeting to be acknowledged by the membership.
6. LCAS will issue a press release and selected students are reminded to notify their schools to publicize the LCAS award(s) at school commencement(s).
7. Checks will be sent or presented to students in early-mid August upon proof of college/university registration.
